The fabulous fun weekend will be centred at the recreation centre in the Pioneer RV Park and Campground. This is located just south of Whitehorse.

Registration cost will be of \$60.00 per person and will include breakfast/brunch on both Saturday and Sunday as well as the steak supper Saturday night. Children under 12 years of age will not be charged.

Travel to the Yukon

Several of you have asked about the cost of travel to the Yukon. Flying to the Yukon from Vancouver or Edmonton is much cheaper than in years past. Both Air Canada and Air North fly into Whitehorse and their websites are currently saying that you can fly Whitehorse from Edmonton, Calgary or Vancouver in July for \$165.00 each way. With taxes, etc, the cost of a return airfare works out to about \$400.00 per person to come up for the weekend.

We do have a convention rate with Air North – just call in with you reservation and quote E0LXUQ62 and you will get an additional 10% off their best rate. So please double check your budget and maybe you can still plan to join us.

Malamute Saloon

The Malamute Saloon will be open for the weekend. We might not be able to completely recreate the atmosphere of the original --- but ---- we will do our best!! The bar will feature beer from the Yukon Brewing Company. This is a local Whitehorse brewery that is rapidly making a reputation for great beer across western Canada. You will find it on tap in a number of bar and lounges in Alberta and BC and in many liquor stores. We do encourage responsible drinking but if would not be a Clinton Creek Reunion if we did not have a saloon.



Miners Cash and Carry Inventory

- 1. Travel Mugs These are fairly standard design travel mugs with a handle and a lid imprinted with the Clinton Creek Shovel logo (A).
- 2. Ceramic Coffee Mugs Just like the ones we used in the cafeteria and just like the ones we had in 1990 --- White with the Clinton Creek Shovel logo (A) in black.
- 3. Jim Robb Fleece T- Shirt There will be the opportunity to order a long sleeved fleece T-shirt with a repeat of an original Jim Robb drawing (B) done for the 1990 reunion. This item is likely to be expensive so we will take orders at the reunion and sent it to all customers after the end of July.
- 4. Jim Robb T- Shirt This will be a long sleeved lighter weight T-shirt, again featuring the Jim Robb drawing (B) done for the 1990 reunion.
- 5. Clinton Creek Shovel Golf Shirt This is a short sleeved "golf" style shirt with a small Clinton Creek Shovel logo (A) on the pocket.
- 6. Malamute Saloon T-shirt This is a short sleeved t-shirt with a reproduction on the Malamute T-shirt design (C) sold in the bar in Clinton Creek
